SAFEGUARDING POLICY

1. Purpose and Scope

Cyprus Aydın University is committed to ensuring the safety, well-being, and security of all individuals within its community, including students, academic and administrative staff, and visitors. This policy outlines the safeguarding and security measures implemented to maintain a safe and supportive environment across the university campus.

2. Coverage

This policy applies to:

- All enrolled students
- All academic and administrative staff
- Visitors and guests on campus
- Contractors and service providers

3. Campus Security Measures

The university employs comprehensive safety measures to guarantee the security of its premises and all individuals within. The campus is fully enclosed, with a single controlled entrance and exit point. Entry to the campus is regulated through a card access and turnstile system, requiring all students and staff to scan their identification cards when entering and exiting the premises. Visitors may enter the campus only with temporary visitor cards issued by the security office.

4. Surveillance System

To ensure continuous monitoring and safety, the entire university campus is equipped with 56 surveillance cameras, operating **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**. All recordings are securely stored and may be reviewed by authorized personnel only.

- Block A: 16 cameras
- Block B: 13 cameras
- Block C: 15 cameras

5. On-site Security Personnel

The university maintains **24/7 on-site** security staff who monitor campus safety, manage visitor access, and respond promptly to any incidents or emergencies. Security officers are trained to handle various situations professionally, ensuring the protection of all members of the university community.

6. Fire Safety and Emergency Response

Cyprus Aydın University has a comprehensive fire alarm and emergency notification system installed throughout the campus.

In the event of a fire, once the alarm is triggered, the system automatically notifies the General Directorate of Police, and firefighting units are immediately dispatched to the campus.

All buildings are equipped with clearly marked emergency exits and evacuation routes to ensure a quick and safe evacuation process.

7. Safeguarding Commitment

Cyprus Aydın University is dedicated to providing a safe and inclusive learning and working environment, free from harm, harassment, or discrimination. All members of the university community share the responsibility of maintaining this environment and are encouraged to report any safeguarding concerns or suspicious behavior to campus security or administrative authorities immediately.

8. Review and Compliance

This policy will be reviewed annually or as required to ensure continued compliance with institutional and legal safeguarding standards in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC).
