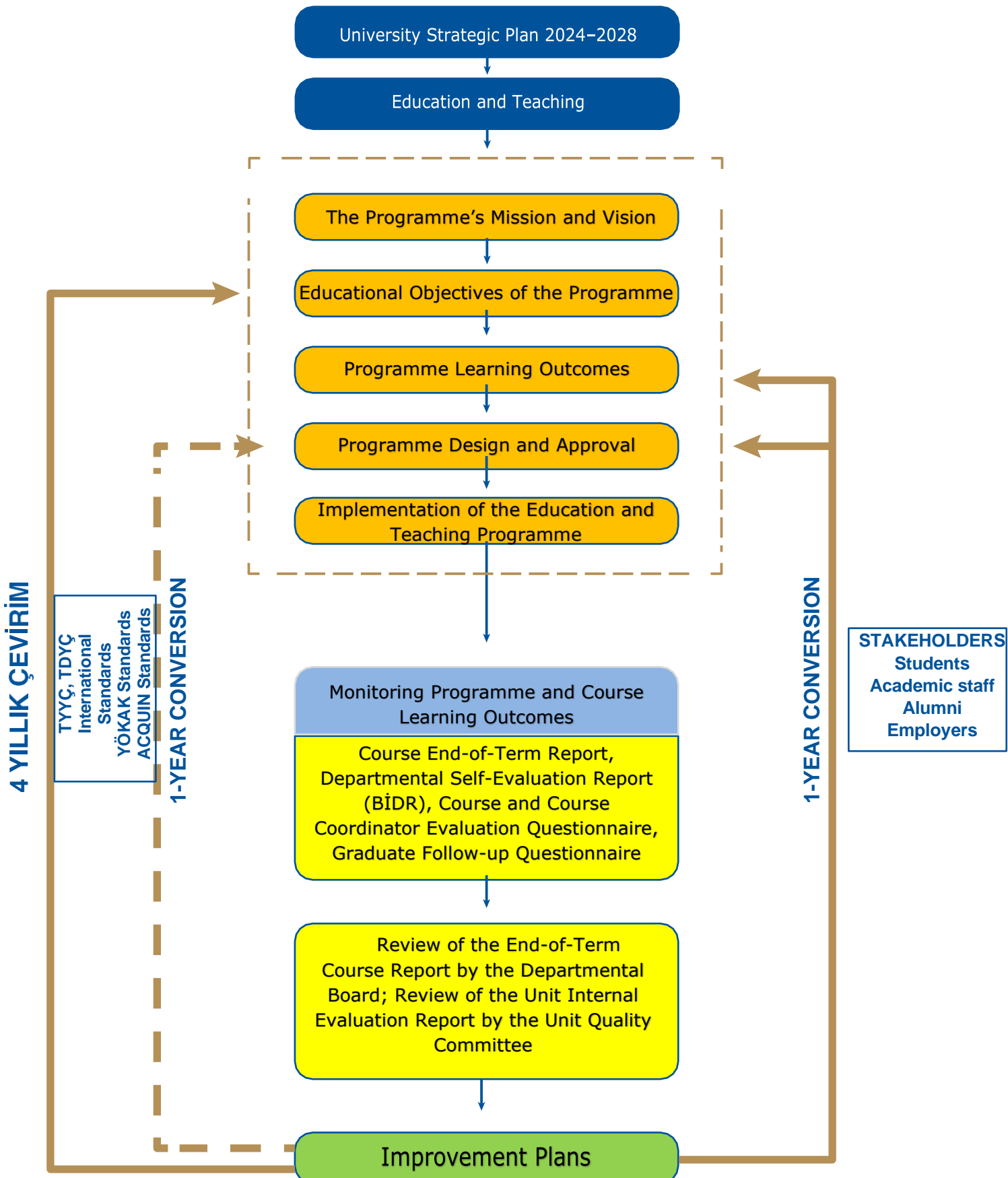

Planning: Our university's education and training processes are planned by the faculties, institutes, and vocational schools. Within the scope of these processes, proposals for the opening of new courses/programmes, as well as studies concerning course/programme revisions, are carried out by the relevant academic units in accordance with the Directive of the Education and Training Commission of Cyprus Aydın University. These are subsequently approved by the Senate and, where necessary, submitted to YÖDAK for approval. The Registrar's Office, the Education and Training Commission, and the Planning Unit undertake an active role in the planning of educational and instructional processes.

Implementation: The educational and instructional processes of our University are implemented by the academic units of faculties, institutes, and vocational schools under the leadership of senior management and unit administrators.

Check: The monitoring of the educational and instructional processes of our University is carried out through course and course instructor evaluation surveys administered to students, end-of-term course reports, Unit Internal Evaluation Reports, and graduate tracking surveys. In the end-of-term course reports, the level at which the course learning outcomes have been achieved is evaluated. The results of these monitoring mechanisms provide guidance for improvements.

Act: The monitoring and evaluation of the educational and instructional processes of our University are carried out at the level of faculties, institutes, and vocational schools. Required curriculum revisions and/or course schedule updates are processed through the relevant boards of the academic units and, following Senate approval, are put into practice.
