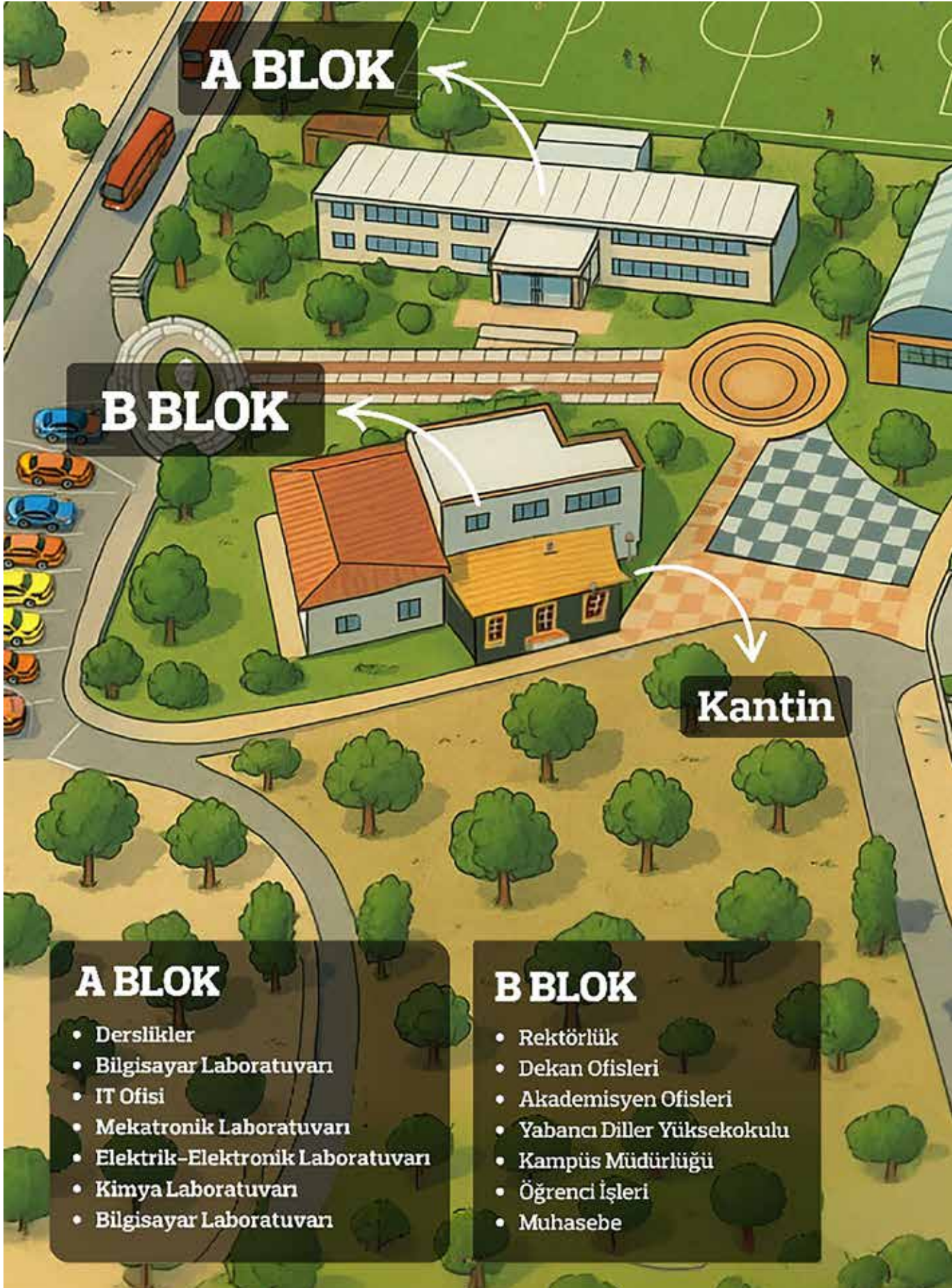

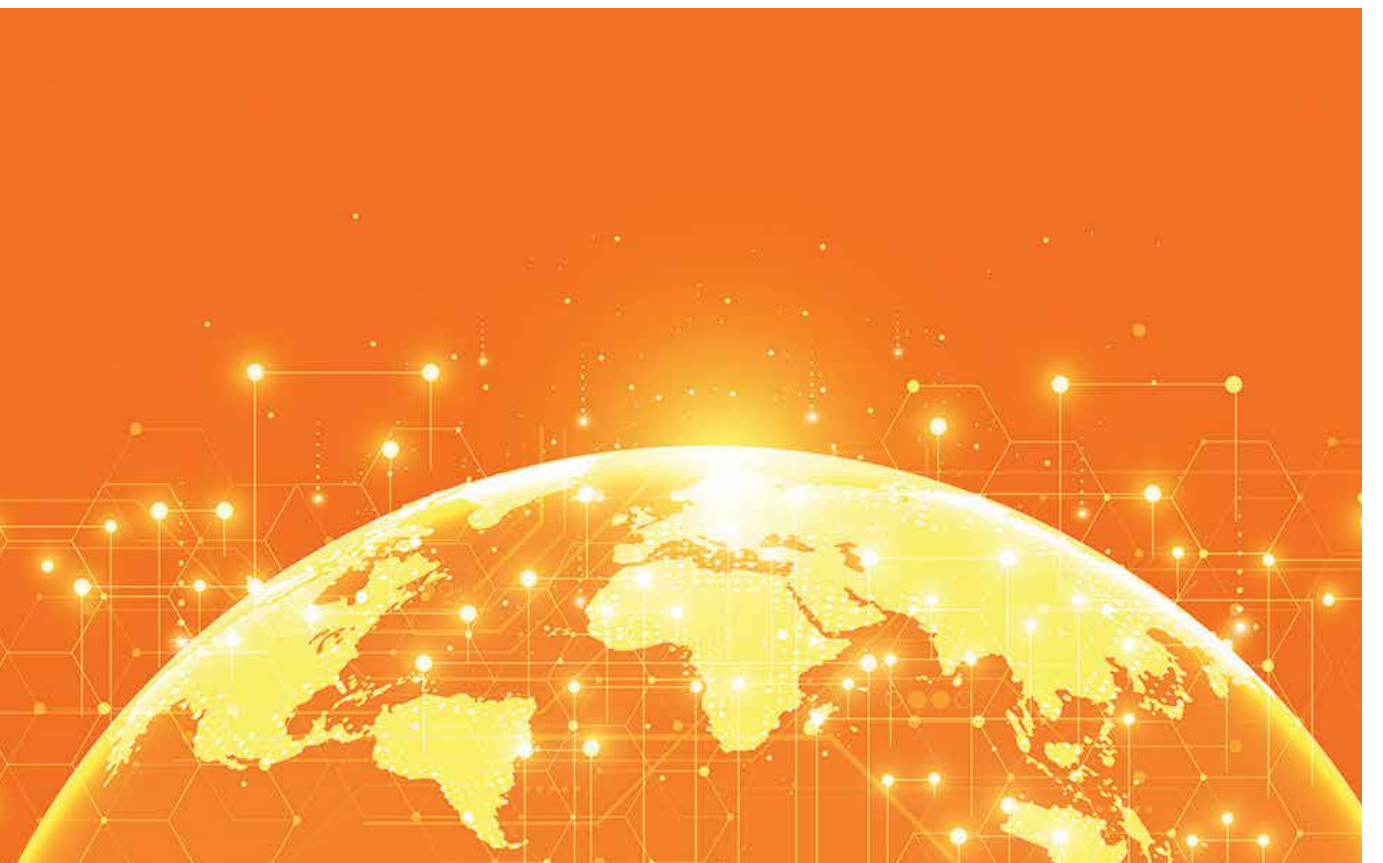

WHAT IS A DOUBLE MAJOR PROGRAM (DMP)?

The Double Major Program offers undergraduate students the opportunity to take courses from a second undergraduate program parallel to their primary field of study and earn a diploma from both programs upon successful completion.

For programs with a required minimum placement ranking, students who wish to apply for a Double Major must also meet the ranking criteria set by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) for the relevant academic year, in addition to the other conditions stated in the applicable regulations.

When Can Students Apply for the Double Major Program?

Students enrolled in a four-year undergraduate program may apply for a Double Major Program no earlier than the beginning of the 3rd semester and no later than the beginning of the 5th semester, provided they meet specific requirements.

To be eligible, the student must have successfully completed all courses in their major program, have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 out of 4.00, and rank within the top 20% of their class based on academic success.

If the student's GPA is 3.00 or higher but their class ranking is not within the top 20%, they may still apply if their university entrance score is equal to or higher than the base score required for the second major program, and if it matches the relevant score type.

WHAT IS A MINOR PROGRAM?

What is a Minor Program?

A Minor Program allows undergraduate students to take courses in another academic discipline in addition to their primary major, and earn a certificate upon successful completion.

When Can Students Apply for the Minor Program?

Applications for a Minor Program can be submitted starting from the beginning of the 3rd semester of a four-year undergraduate program. Students must fulfill the requirements no later than the beginning of the 6th semester. To be eligible, students must have successfully completed all courses in their major program up to that point and must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 out of 4.00.

*Double Major and Minor Scholarships

Students enrolled at Cyprus Aydın University can benefit from their main departmental scholarships while pursuing Double Major or Minor programs.

Application, Admission, and Continuation Requirements for Double Major and Minor Programs

The procedures and conditions regarding the application, admission, and continuation in Double Major and Minor programs are regulated in accordance with the "Regulation on the Principles of Transfer Between Associate and Undergraduate Degree Programs, Double Major, Minor, and Inter-Institutional Credit Transfers in Higher Education Institutions" and the "Cyprus Aydın University Directive on Double Major and Minor Programs."

OUR SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES



CYPRUS AYDIN UNIVERSITY INCENTIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, students who rank among the top 1000 in any score category of the University Entrance Examinations organized by the Higher Education Council Measurement, Selection and Placement Center of the Republic of Turkey (YÖK-ÖSYM), and who are admitted to a program at Cyprus Aydın University, are awarded a full (100%) tuition scholarship according to central exam scores. Also, all international students individually can apply up to 85% under specific countries scholarship

TOP HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES OF TRNC SCHOLARSHIP

Cyprus Aydın University grants scholarships to TRNC citizens who graduated from high schools in the TRNC with a "Very Good" diploma and are admitted to any of the university's four-year undergraduate programs. Additionally, Turkish citizens who continuously completed their high school education in the TRNC are also eligible. The scholarship rates are as follows:

- **100% tuition fee scholarship for first-place high school graduates**
- **95% tuition fee scholarship for second-place high school graduates**
- **90% tuition fee scholarship for third-place high school graduates**

TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

Students transferring horizontally to programs at Cyprus Aydın University, in accordance with relevant regulations and meeting the necessary conditions, are eligible for tuition fee discounts ranging from 50% up to 100%.

MARTYR CHILD AND DISABLED VETERAN SCHOLARSHIP (TRNC AND TURKEY)

Children of individuals officially recognized as martyrs or disabled veterans under the laws of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) and the Republic of Turkey are eligible for a 75% tuition exemption scholarship for associate and undergraduate programs at Cyprus Aydın University. The scholarship duration covers the standard length of the program, including one preparatory year if applicable.

HONOR AND HIGH HONOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who have completed at least two semesters in their enrolled program and achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 with a "High Honor" distinction may receive extra scholarships up to 20%. Those with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 and an "Honor" distinction may be awarded extra scholarships up to 20%. Scholarships are granted according to the allocated quotas.

SUCCESSFUL ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to students who have represented Cyprus Aydın University individually or as a team in sports tournaments approved by the University Board and achieved first place; who actively participate in one of the university's sports clubs; or who have been national athletes in their sport in their home country. The scholarship covers tuition fees and is granted under the condition that the student maintains an active and successful sports career at the university. The scope, duration, and conditions of the scholarship are determined by the University Board and approved by the Board of Trustees.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

At Cyprus Aydın University, a tuition fee discount of 50% is granted to each sibling enrolled, and a 75% discount is applied to the third sibling. These discounts cannot be combined with any other scholarships or financial aid packages.

INSTITUTIONAL DISCOUNT FOR CONTRACTED ORGANIZATIONS (WITHIN TRNC)

Tuition fee discounts are applied to personnel accepted to or currently studying at Cyprus Aydın University from institutions with which special agreements have been made, in accordance with the terms of the respective agreements.

CONTRACTED INSTITUTION DISCOUNT

Students coming from institutions with formal agreements may be eligible for tuition discounts, provided that they meet the specified conditions as outlined in the agreement between the respective institution and Cyprus Aydın University.

Note: Students eligible for more than one scholarship or discount may only benefit from the one with the highest rate; discounts or scholarships cannot be combined.

APPLICATION AND RESEARCH CENTERS

Cyprus Aydın University conducts forward-looking research at the intersection of science and society. Our research centers contribute to both academic life and societal advancement through interdisciplinary collaboration, social responsibility projects, and innovative practices.

Child Research, Education and Practice Centre (ÇAEM)

The Child Research, Education and Practice Center at Cyprus Aydın University is dedicated to supporting child development through interdisciplinary research and educational programs. The center generates innovative solutions to address children's needs in areas such as early childhood education, psychological well-being, and social development.

By integrating research with practical applications, the center organizes training programs, workshops, and community awareness initiatives for parents, educators, and caregivers—thereby promoting the holistic development of children.

Center for Women's Studies (KAÜNKAM)

LABORATORIES



Anatomy Laboratory

The Anatomy Laboratory enables students to study the structure of the human body through anatomical models and digital simulations. Students gain hands-on experience in identifying organ systems and understanding their functions and spatial arrangement.

Clinical Skills Laboratory

In this laboratory, fundamental nursing skills such as injection techniques, wound care, and patient care procedures are practiced on simulators. The use of realistic patient mannequins allows students to safely simulate and rehearse critical care scenarios.

First Aid and Emergency Practice Laboratory

This laboratory is designed to train students in essential emergency medical interventions such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), artificial respiration, and trauma response. Through simulated real-time scenarios, students enhance their rapid decision-making and intervention skills in a controlled environment.

Neurological, Orthopaedic and Cardiopulmonary Rehabilitation Laboratory

This laboratory is designed to support practical training and research in neurological, orthopedic, and cardiopulmonary rehabilitation. Students gain practical experience in assessment methods, therapeutic interventions, and exercise-based rehabilitation programs. Students develop skills in designing and applying individualized exercise protocols aimed at improving strength, mobility, endurance, and functional performance across diverse patient populations.



Phantom Laboratory

The Phantom Laboratory provides technical training using anatomically realistic tissue models specifically designed for surgical and invasive procedures. This allows students to develop manual skills in a safe environment without risk to actual patients.

Manipulation and Electrotherapy Laboratory

Manipulation techniques targeting the musculoskeletal system are taught through spinal and joint mobilization practices. Students are trained under the supervision of expert instructors to apply appropriate hand positioning and controlled force safely and effectively.

This laboratory also provides practical training in physiotherapy applications using electrotherapy modalities such as TENS, ultrasound, and electrical stimulation. Students gain hands-on experience in applying these techniques and understanding their effectiveness in pain management, tissue healing, and rehabilitation processes.

Computer Laboratory

Equipped with modern hardware and software, the Computer Laboratory provides students with an ideal environment to conduct research, complete coursework, and collaborate on group projects—enhancing their digital skills.

Opticianry Laboratory

Students receive training in identifying refractive errors using ophthalmic examination devices and practice lens cutting and frame adjustment techniques. The program emphasizes hands-on learning to develop effective vision correction solutions for patients.

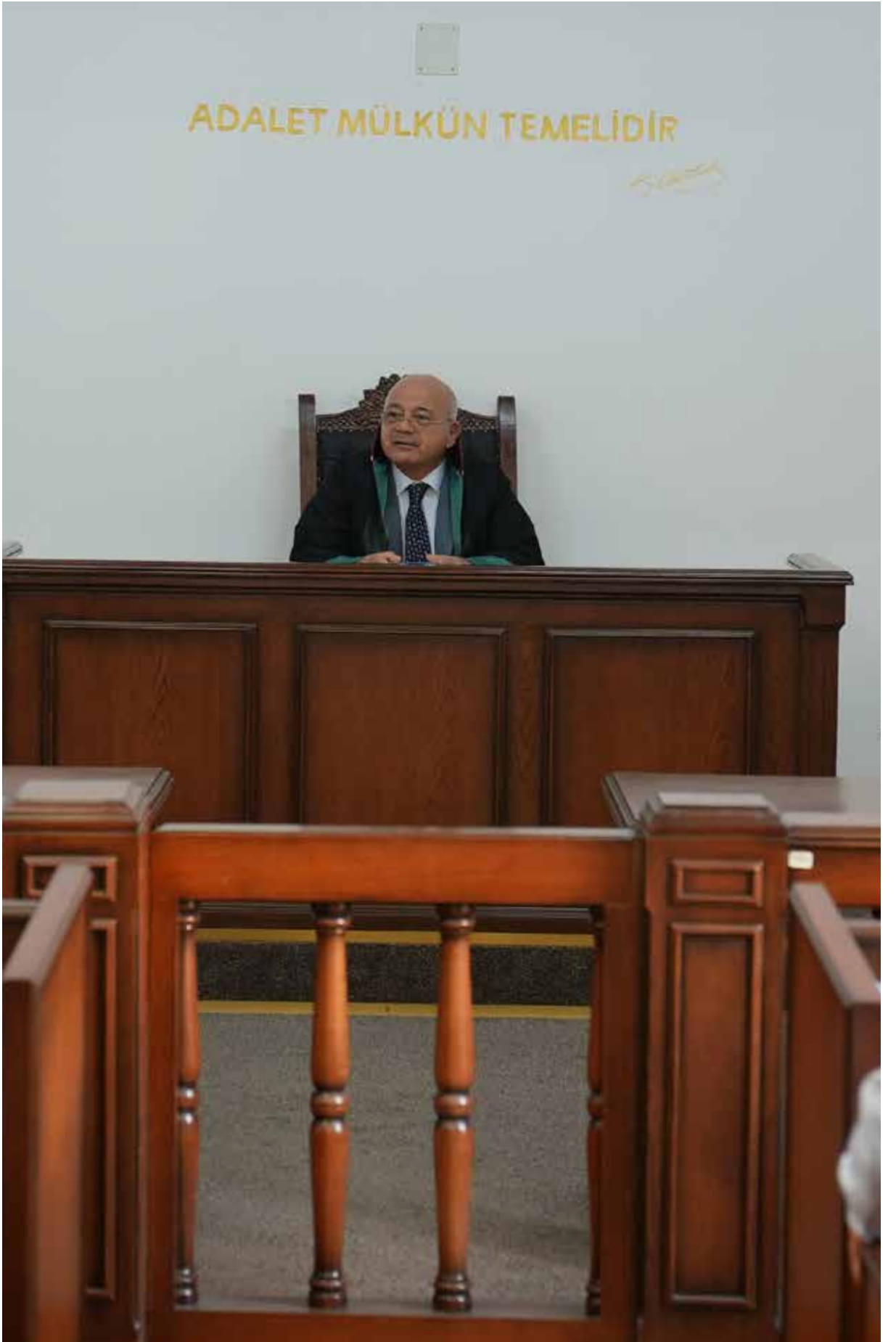

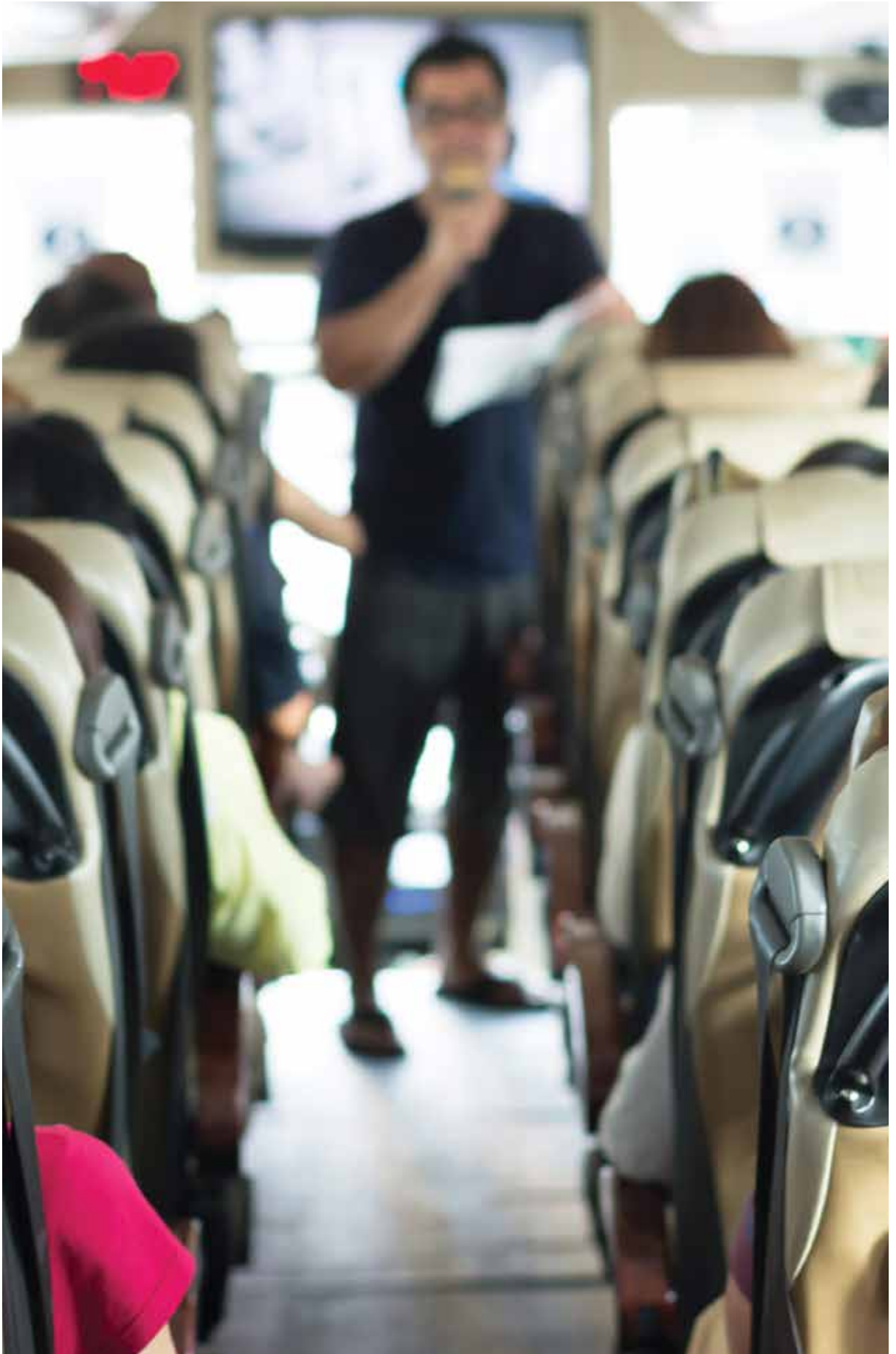

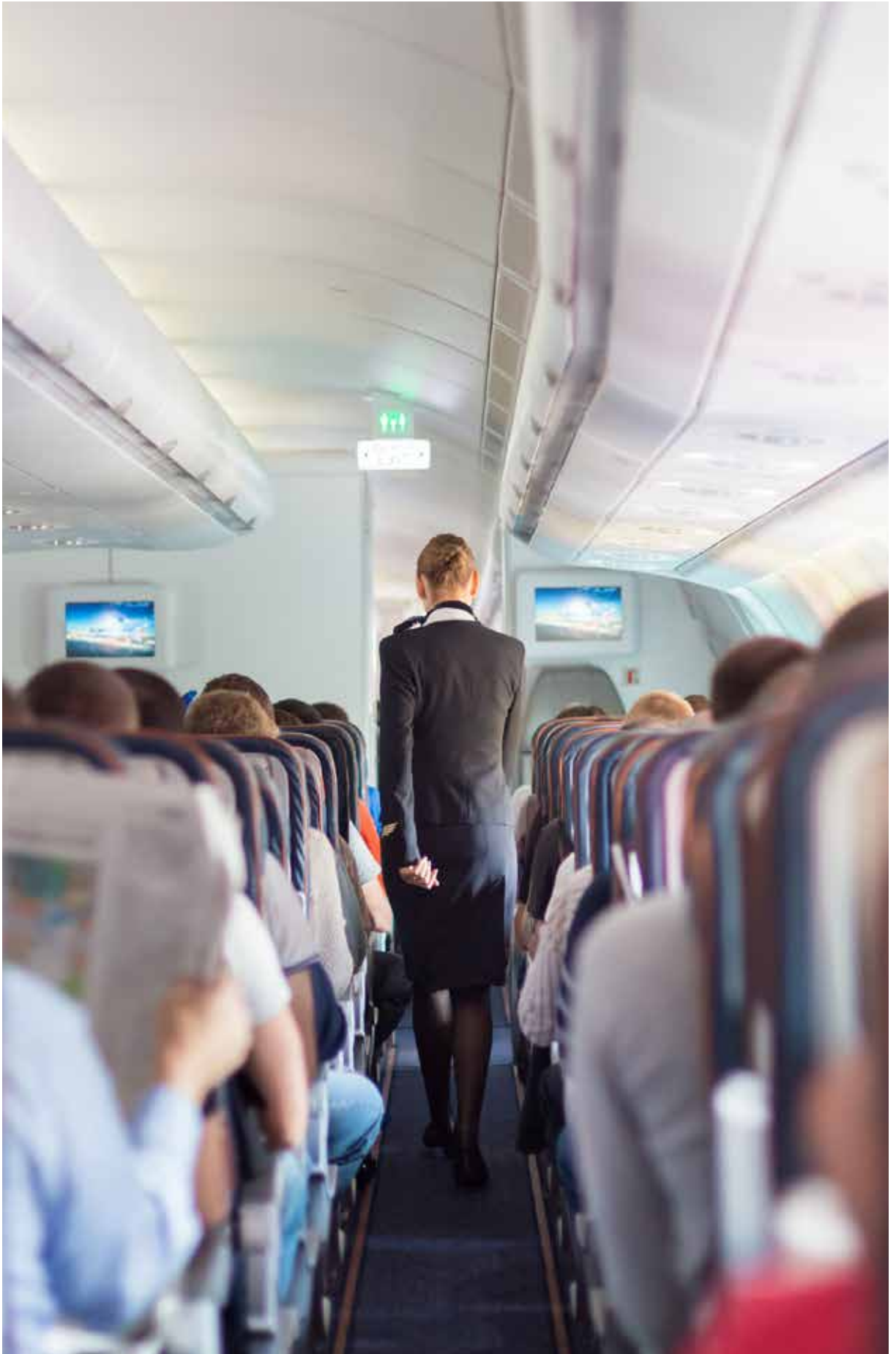

MASTER'S PROGRAMS



Master's Program in Educational Administration (Turkish/English)

The Master's Program in Educational Administration is designed for professionals who aspire to assume leadership positions in educational institutions. The program focuses on the management of contemporary educational systems, strategic planning, quality assurance, and leadership.

Program Objective:

The aim of this program is to train educational administrators who possess the leadership, communication, decision-making, and problem-solving skills necessary for the effective management of educational systems, and who are equipped to meet the requirements of the modern era.

Graduate Profile:

Graduates of the program are qualified to serve as administrators, assistant principals, education specialists, or coordinators in public and private educational institutions. Additionally, graduates who pursue an academic career path may continue their studies in doctoral programs.

Program in Guidance and Psychological Counseling (Turkish)

The Master's Program in Guidance and Psychological Counseling is a graduate-level program offered with both thesis and non-thesis options, aiming to train specialists who can support individuals' psychosocial development.

Program Objective:

The objective of this program is to educate professionals who can guide individuals of different age groups in their personal, social, educational, and career development; who adhere to ethical principles; who are capable of effectively utilizing scientific methods; and who can provide contemporary guidance and psychological counseling services.

Graduate Profile:

Graduates of the program may work as psychological counselors (guidance counselors) in schools, as specialists providing counseling services in private counseling centers, special education and rehabilitation institutions, or public agencies. Graduates of the thesis track are also eligible to pursue doctoral studies and continue their academic careers.

MASTER'S PROGRAMS



Master's Program in Nursing (Turkish)

The Master's Program in Nursing is a graduate-level program designed for nurses who seek to specialize in the field of healthcare. Offered with both thesis and non-thesis options, the program aims to equip students with knowledge and skills in areas such as nursing research methods, advanced clinical practices, health education, and leadership and management competencies.

Program Objective:

The objective of this program is to train expert nurses who can plan, implement, and evaluate healthcare services aimed at improving the health of individuals, families, and communities through a scientific and research-based approach. The program also aims to equip graduates with the competencies required to take on leadership roles within the healthcare system.

Graduate Profile:

Graduates of the program may work as clinical nurses, nurse educators, nurse administrators, or academicians in hospitals, community health centers, educational institutions, and other healthcare organizations.



Master's Program in Nutrition and Dietetics (Turkish)

The Master's Program in Nutrition and Dietetics is designed to train specialists capable of providing nutrition services at both individual and community levels, with the aim of promoting a healthy lifestyle and preventing diseases. Offered with both thesis and non-thesis options, the program provides comprehensive knowledge and practical skills in areas such as nutritional sciences, public nutrition, food safety, metabolism, diet therapy, and research methodologies.

Program Objective:

Graduates of the program may work in hospitals, community health centers, private nutrition counseling centers, sports clubs, educational institutions, and the food industry.

Master's Program in Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation (Turkish)

The Master's Program in Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation is designed for bachelor's degree graduates who wish to specialize in physiotherapy, with the aim of enhancing individuals' mobility and functional capacity, improving quality of life, and contributing to the maintenance of health. Program Objective:

The objective of this program is to train physiotherapists with advanced knowledge and skills in the prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and rehabilitation of physical dysfunctions. Graduates are expected to follow scientific advancements, demonstrate a strong sense of ethical responsibility, and possess a research-oriented and leadership mindset.

Graduate Profile:

Graduates of the program may work as physiotherapists, educators, or researchers in hospitals, rehabilitation centers, sports clubs, private clinics, elderly care facilities, and academic institutions.



Master's Program in Business Administration (Turkish and English)

The Master's Program in Business Administration is offered in both Turkish and English, and is designed to train professionals who can adapt to the evolving dynamics of the global business environment, think strategically, and demonstrate strong leadership skills. Structured with both thesis and non-thesis options, the program provides both theoretical and practical knowledge in core areas such as finance, marketing, human resource management, strategic management, and business analytics.

Program Objective:

The objective of the program is to educate managers and specialists equipped to compete in national and international business environments, with advanced analytical thinking and problem-solving skills, capable of contributing to strategic decision-making processes.

Graduate Profile:

Graduates of the program may pursue careers as managers, project leaders, specialists, or consultants in private sector companies, public institutions, and international organizations.

MASTER'S PROGRAMS



Master's Program in Banking and Finance (English)

Master's Program in Marketing Management (English)

Graduate Profile:

Graduates of the program can pursue careers as specialists, consultants, or managers in international and local marketing departments, digital marketing agencies, brand management firms, and advertising and communication agencies.

MASTER'S PROGRAMS



Master's Program in Clinical Psychology (Turkish)

The Master's Program in Clinical Psychology is a graduate program delivered in Turkish, designed for professionals who aim to specialize in the assessment, treatment, and psychotherapy of psychological disorders. Offered in both thesis and non-thesis formats, the program provides in-depth theoretical and practical knowledge in clinical psychology, psychotherapy techniques, psychological assessment tools, and child and adolescent psychology.
